TRANSFER SLED TRACTOR PULLING RULES
(EXCLUDING JUNIOR & LADIES PULL)
(Revised 3/03/16)

TRANSFER SLED GENERAL RULES (Including 3 mph and 5 mph classes):

1. All pullers must be 16 years old or have a parent or legal guardian sign them in.. All tractor and operators must weigh in before the pull. Contestants must sign waiver at time of weigh in. An adult responsible for the underage contestant must be at track side during the pull while minors are pulling. No one is allowed on the pulling track during the pull except track workers.
2. Driver must remain seated and signal tractor is out of gear when hitching and unhitching from the pulling device. Driver must remain firmly seated (no bouncing) and keep one hand on the wheel at all times during a pull. Driver must obey signals from track flagmen.
3. Wheelie bars are required for 8 mph class. Recommended for 5 mph and lower.
4. If any weights or parts fall off the tractor it will be disqualified.
5. If the rear tire of the tractor touches the out of bounds line the pull will be disqualified.
6. Orange cones are set 100ft from the beginning of the track (or at the official's discretion). If the speed limit horn sounds after the front of the sled pan passes the cones, the pull is disqualified.
7. Pullers may not protest another tractor after it leaves the track. Judges may check any tractor at any time.
8. No dual tires, chains, or 4x4 tractors allowed.
9. Weights cannot extend more than 11 feet from the center of the rear axle forward, drawbar height for all rubber tired tractors shall not exceed 19" and hitching point must extend beyond radius of rear tractor tires at 19" high. All hitches must be rigid in all directions and with a 3" hole. All hitches must meet judges standards.
10. Working kill switch must be within reach of driver and fenders are recommended on all tractors.
11. Tire size is 0-5000 lbs 15.5 x 38. 18.4 for 33" and smaller rims. 5001 and up is unlimited. **Top cut tires only.**
12. All rules and unforeseen issues are subject to the judge's discretion.
13. All tractor equipment with governor from factory must work.

Pullers can pull in multiple classes

8 MPH

1. Speed limit is 8 mph. No beeps allowed after 100 ft cone (or judges discretion).
2. All tractors must have a working kill switch.
3. Hitch must be ridged in all directions, no higher than 19". And no less than 18" from the center of the axle to the hook point. Must have a 3" wide x 3.5" deep hole.
4. Tire size is unlimited. Full cut tires allowed.
5. Fenders and wheelie bars are required. Wheelie bars must be behind the tires and strong enough to support the weight of the tractor. Pads must hit before the hook does.
